Short Description of the Program (within 200 words

Principal of Raja Birendra Chandra College, was the Organising Chairman. Mrs Arpita Pal , HOD of Department of English was the Organising Secretary. Mr Tritas Mondal, SACT of the Department of English, was the Convener. Dr Shyamal Acharya, SACT of English, was the Key Note Speaker. Dr Abu Siddik, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Plassey College, Plassey, Nadia and Mr Subhajit Das, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Rani Dhanya Kumari College, Jiaganj, Murshidabad were the honourable Speakers . Mrs Arpita Pal , the anchor of the webinar, briefly explained the historical and social background of Indian Classical Literature.
