The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective from 9<sup>th</sup> June 2022 up to five years to establish an affiliations by and between-

Mathabhanga College, Mathabhanga, Coochbehar, West Bengal, Government Aided undergraduate College with its office at P.O.-Mathabhanga, Dist.- Coochbehar, West Bengal (India), Pin-736146, established in 1969 affiliated to CBPBU, hereinafter referred to as Mathabhanga College and represented by it's Principal-In-Charge namely Dr. Sulagna Dutta, D/O Sri. Subir Dutta aged about 45 years by faith hinduism, residing at Shib Jagya Residency, Dolapara, East Khagrabari, Cooch Behar, West Bengal – 736101, referred to as FIRST PARTY.

**And**

Raja Birendra Chandra College, Kandi, Murshidabad, a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate degree College with its office at P.O.- Kandi, Dist. Murshidabad, West Bengal (India), Pin-742137, established in 1965 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereinafter referred to as Raja Birendra Chandra College and represented by its Principal namely Dr. Atish Chandra Ghosh, S/O Late Dhirendra Kumar Ghosh aged about 53 years by faith Hinduism, residing at Bijoy Bagan, P.O. - Kandi, , District-Murshidabad, West Bengal 742137, referred to as SECOND PARTY, for the purpose of exchange of faculty.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/collectively as college/colleges.

**PREAMBLE**

Whereas, Mathabhanga College and Raja Birendra Chandra College have many areas of common interest in Arts and commerce, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, Mathabhanga College and Raja Birendra College have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

**ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVES**

Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

**A. Faculty exchange**

- (i) Each institution will promote the exchange of faculty for the common UG Honours & Programme Courses.
- (ii) Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both the institutions.
- (iii) Collaboration in teaching, research development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- (iv) Conducting lectures both in offline and blended mode.
- (v) Exchange of academic materials and publications.
- (vi) Undertaking joint research wherever feasible.





- (vii) Organizing and participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions.
- (viii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible.
- (ix) Each Teacher will responsible for his/her own transportation and daily allowances to and from the host institution.
- (x) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period.
- (xi) To use laboratory facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

Mathabhanga College and Raja Birendra Chandra College agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation

## **ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION**

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the Principal of each college. Further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once or twice a year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

## **ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION**

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

## **ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.





## ARTICLES 5: VALIDITY

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of five years commencing from the effective date (9<sup>th</sup> June, 2022). Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

## ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice one month in advance to the other institution.

## ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

## ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Mathabhanga College and Raja Birendra Chandra College welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions set out as above.

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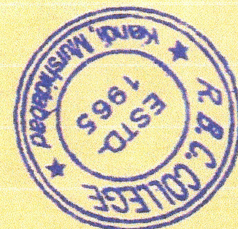
