About the College

Raja Birendra Chandra College, formerly known as Kandi Raj College of Commerce, was established on 16th August 1965 in the premises of Kandi Raj College in the evening shift under the affiliation of Calcutta University to cater commerce education to the students of Kandi subdivision and its adjoining area. The college was renamed as Raja Birendra Chandra College of Commerce on and from 2nd March 1973. From July 1977 the college has been appeared in the morning shift. The college was shifted from the premises of Kandi Raj College to its present site in April 1998. There was a long term demand from the students, guardians and intellectuals of the locality for the introduction of Arts stream at the degree level in the college. The college authority introduced general Arts stream at the degree level from 1998 under the affiliation of Kalyani University. The college was again renamed as Raja Birendra Chandra College in 2002. Now it is a full fledged college for Arts and Commerce stream.

About the Seminar
