The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective from 7th February 2023 to 30th June 2027 to establish an affiliation by and between-

Raja Birendra Chandra College, Kandi, Murshidabad, a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate degree College with its office at P.O.- Kandi, District – Murshidabad, West Bengal (India), Pin – 742137, established in 1965 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereinafter referred to as Raja Birendra Chandra College and represented by its Principal, referred to as FIRST PARTY,

AND

Indian Red Cross Society, Kandi, Murshidabad, a West Bengal State Branch with its office at P.O. –Kandi, District – Murshidabad, West Bengal (India), Pin – 742137, established in 1945 at Kandi Branch, hereinafter referred to as Indian Red Cross Society, Kandi Sub Division Branch and represented by its Secretary, referred to as SECOND PARTY, for the purpose of exchange of faculty.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/ collectively as institution/Institutions.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, Raja Birendra Chandra College and Indian Red Cross Society have many areas of common interest in Social Works, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, Pedagogy, Social Work and research.

Now therefore, Raja Birendra Chandra College and Indian Red Cross Society have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVES

Both Institutions agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty exchanges

- i) Health Awareness Programme exchange (First Aid, Blood Donation Camp, Blood donation Awareness Camp etc.)
- ii) Organizing and participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions,
- Each institution will promote the exchange of faculty as well as to conduct special class in blended mode for Students.
- iv) Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both the institutions.

- v) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- vi) Conducting lectures
- vii) Exchange of academic materials and publications
- viii) Undertaking joint research wherever feasible
- ix) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work wherever feasible
- x) Each Teacher will be responsible for his / her own transportation and daily allowances to and from the host institution.
- xi) To use laboratory facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

Raja Birendra Chandra College and Indian Red Cross Society agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the Principal/Secretary of institution each college. Further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two head of the institutions and the two Coordinators will periodically (once or twice a year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two institutions.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two institutions will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both institutions.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the institutions in this MoU. Both the institutions shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both institutions.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of five academic year commencing from the effective date. (7th February 2023 to 30th June 2027). Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of one month in advance to the other institution.

ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two institutions. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, head of both institutions will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Raja Birendra Chandra College and Indian Red Cross Society welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions set out as above.
